

2000 Sangiovese Walla Walla Valley

Winemaker Tasting Notes

Our 2000 Sangiovese is our finest since we began producing this varietal in 1995. Since then we've really fallen in love with the variety and the wines it produces. Our 2000 Sangiovese is a very dark wine with an intensely fruit driven nose, and elements of strawberries, dust, roses, tar, charcoal, and wood. This is a serious Sangiovese with long-term aging potential.

Vineyards in this Wine

Pepper Bridge Farms, Seven Hills Vineyard, Mill Creek Upland Vineyard, and Leonetti Estate Vineyard, all of Walla Walla Valley.

Blending Detail

Sangiovese 81.4%, Syrah 15.2%, Cabernet Sauvignon 3.4%.

Oak Aging Profile

This wine was aged in a mix of new and used American and French oak barrels and puncheons for fifteen months.
