## WINEMAKER NOTES

**BEAUTIFULLY SATURATED COLOR** and, even after a full decade of aging, doesn't possess a tinge of browning. 2012 is one of my favorite vintages and is widely regarded as one of Washington State's best. Just now beginning to develop secondary aromas, the nose is still remarkably fresh and full of macerated raspberry, dried figs, and dates, with hints of ocean breeze and graphite. The palate is silky, supple, and dense with notes of raspberry preserves and fresh acidity. Difficult to put down, with an amazingly long and delicious finish. The wine is approaching its prime but will reward beautifully for another decade.
